COMING SUMMER 2016



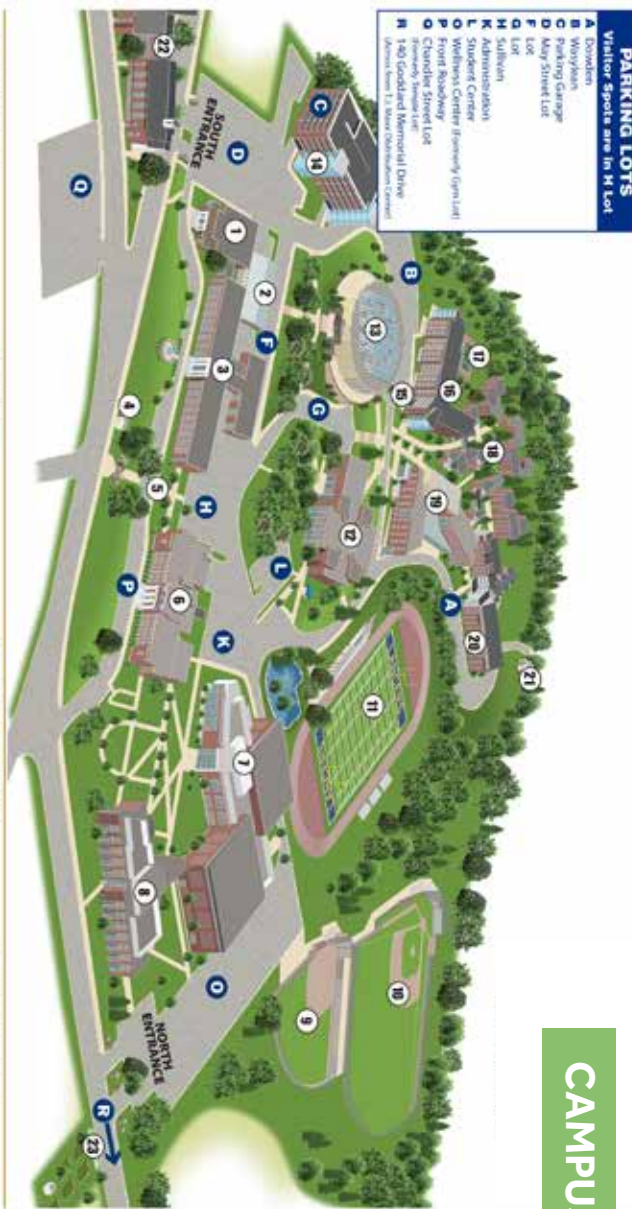
